D E C I S I O N

At the request of INFRA-STOP 2000 Kft. (9343 Beled, Rákóczi u. 118.) marketing of type **INFRA STOP BEH 86** automated extinguishing system – manufactured by the applicant – which protects extractor fans in timber industry, filter housings and containers is

A U T H O R I S E D

A product fiche in Hungarian and a technical description including operation, maintenance, reviews and application constraints of the product shall be placed at the customers' disposal at the time of the marketing; besides it shall be published on the marketer's website prior to commencing marketing.

The authorisation might be withdrawn, if technical, health and environmental protection data and parameters are revealed, which serve as a basis of such an action.

The present authorisation shall not provide an exemption from authorisation requirements by other laws or provide a substitute for other authorisations.

The authorisation is valid until the date of entry into force of the legislation, naturalised standard relevant to the product, not exceeding 31st October 2017. For the continuity of the authorisation, its extension shall be initiated at least two months prior to its date of expiration.

No further appeal by measure of state organisation shall lie against this decision; any revision shall be requested – raising a plea of illegality – by initiating proceedings within 30 days from the date of this decision by means of an application with a Stamp of Duty of 30,000 HUF addressed to the Budapest-Capital Regional Court but submitted to the Ministry of the Interior, National Directorate General for Disaster Management.

During the proceedings a cost of 3,000 HUF incurred, which was borne by the applicant.

A repeatable fine of a maximum of 1,000,000 HUF that is one million HUF shall be imposed on no or inappropriate implementation of this decision.

R E A S O N S

INFRA-STOP 2000 Kft. requested the Ministry of the Interior, National Directorate General for Disaster Management to authorise marketing of the fire-extinguishing system mentioned in the

provision. There are no further national standards or technical specifications for the INFRA STOP BEH 86 fire-extinguishing system.

Pursuant to Article 13 (2) of Act XXXI of 1996 on fire protection, technical rescue and fire brigades 'if there are no fire protection safety requirements for a fire-extinguishing technology product, it shall be marketed, installed, operated and kept in stock with authorisation from the fire protection authority based on official fire protection investigation carried out by it'.

Based on the submitted technical documentation and the official test report no. 659/23/2000 by the Fire Protection Testing Laboratory of the Ministry of the Interior, National Directorate General for Disaster Management Ybl Miklós Technical College (1033 Budapest, Laktanya u. 33.) it was established that the product is suitable for use for fire protection purposes, and the decision in the operative part was taken.

The proceedings were carried out pursuant to regulations of Act CXL of 2004 on the general rules of administrative proceedings and services (hereinafter GRAPS).

Appeal by measure of state organisation was excluded pursuant to point *e*) of Article 100 (1) of GRAPS. Judicial review is pursuant to Article 109 (1) of GRAPS and Article 330 (2) of Act III of 1952 on the code of civil procedure (hereinafter CCP). Exclusive competence of the Budapest-Capital Regional Court is determined pursuant to Article 326 (7) of CCP. The amount of judicial duty is provided by Article 43 (3) of Act XCIII of 1990 on Duties (hereinafter DA).

The applicant paid the duty of 3,000 HUF during the proceedings. The amount of duty is pursuant to Article 29 (1) of DA. The decision about determining and bearing duty was taken pursuant to Article 158 (1) of GRAPS.

My scope of authority is established pursuant to point *a*) of Article 1 (3) of Government Decree No. 259/2011 (XII 7) on fire protection authority organisations, fire protection fines and compulsory accident insurance of fire protection employees.
